

Reading Racetrack




To keep your child motivated to read while home learning, we are introducing a new reading competition across the school called the Reading Racetrack! Every time your child reads, sign a square on the racetrack. When the track is filled send a picture of it to their class teacher. Individual recognition will be given to everyone who fills the track, and the first class to have every pupil submit a completed race track will win a special award!

The racetrack can be printed and completed by hand or completed and saved online.


1. The document should open as PDF in the web browser;




2. On the top left hand side of the screen there is an option to 'save'- click this and save the file in a convenient place in your documents.



3. Along the top left you will also see a 'draw' option. This will let you select a pen and sign directly onto the page.



4. When you have signed, click the save icon again.



When you have signed every box you can send the updated PDF as a document on dojo portfolio or messenger as you would normally send your child's work. Or, if you are using a paper copy, take a picture to send to your child's teacher.

KS2 families, your child's racetrack will look slightly different but the process for editing online is exactly the same!
