Julian Opie: 1958-present, British

- He began drawing aged 11. He draws anything in the world around him.
- He remembers getting an art prize at around the age of 12 after carving a bar of soap into a Henry Moore sculpture. He thinks this first inspired him to explore art.
- The main themes that can been seen in his work include the human body and inspiration from art in history.
- Many of his works show black outlines filled with flat colour and sometimes a head is represented by a circle with a space where the neck would be.


