We hope your children enjoy a day away from their devices!



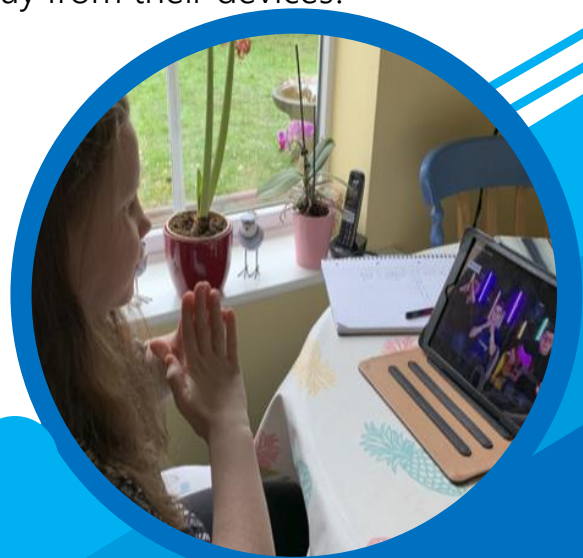
Safer Internet Day
