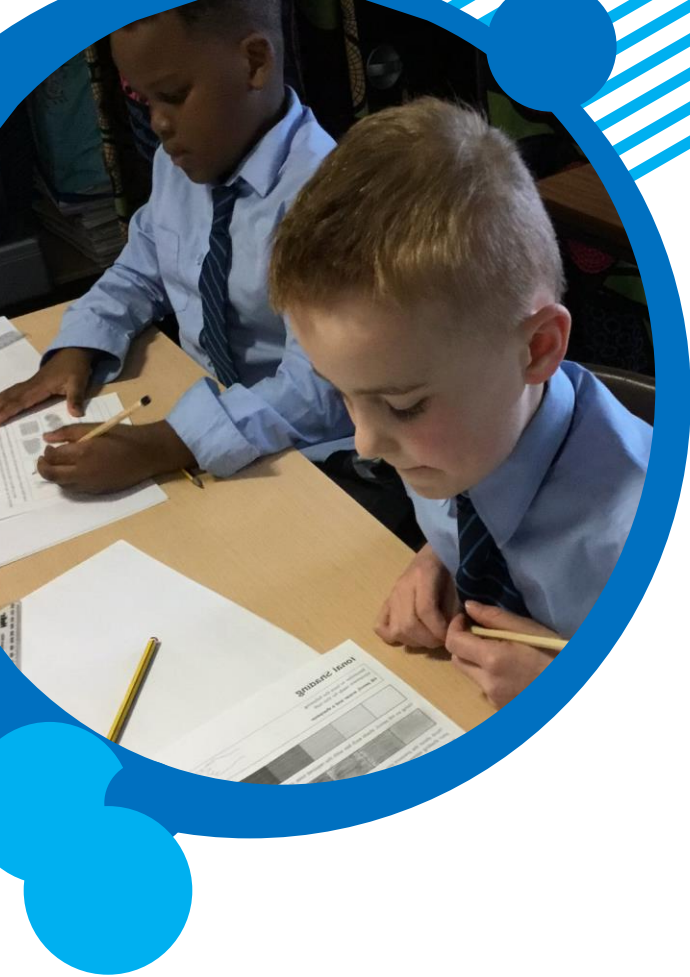
Road Safety

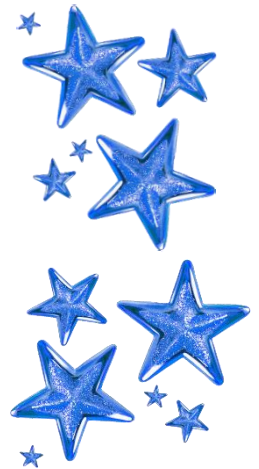
